

Contract terms

Start of contract: from order date
Duration: Unlimited with a minimum term of one year in accordance with point 5 of the General Terms and Conditions of the contract

The product can be used by the same number of the customer's employees (referred to in the following as "authorised users") as the customer has licences.

ACCESS

The eMagazine can be accessed as follows:

- Licence key activation: access via user groups managed using licence keys with individual registration

SCOPE OF PERMITTED USE

When the contract has been signed and full payment of the charges has been made, Springer Fachmedien will grant the customer the non-exclusive, non-transferrable, restricted right to access and use the products listed above, which will be made available to the customer on the www.springerprofessional.de portal. The right of access and use will be granted to the number of authorised users that corresponds to the number of licences bought by the customer.

The scope of each licence is as follows:

The right to display the eMagazine via the access to the online service made available by Springer Fachmedien on not more than one individual PC at one time.

The customer and the authorised users are not entitled to pass the eMagazine on to third parties. The customers and its users are not entitled to publish, reproduce or distribute the documents.

The right to use the documents is granted to the customer and its authorised users only in the context of the provisions of this contractual relationship and the legal restrictions imposed by copyright law.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. This order form is subject to the enclosed General Terms and Conditions for the „springerprofessional.de“ platform that specify the terms and conditions under which Springer Fachmedien makes available the licences referred to above.
2. This order form is binding as soon as it is accepted by Springer Fachmedien. The order form is considered to have been accepted when it is countersigned by Springer Fachmedien at the end of the document or when the access details have been made available by Springer Fachmedien. This order form remains valid until the agreed services are ended in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions.

3. All licence costs exclude any taxes and duties and must be paid in full in euros within thirty (30) days of receipt of the invoice.
4. The licence fee must be paid for 12 months in advance. Invoices are issued annually for the forthcoming 12 months.
5. Except as expressly provided otherwise in the License Agreement, the License Agreement shall be valid for 12 months from the commencement date specified in the License Agreement and shall be renewed for further periods of twelve months unless terminated by either party with 2 months' notice prior to the expiration of the applicable term. The right to extraordinary termination for good cause remains unaffected for both parties.

Any termination must be made in writing. A notice of termination may be sent by letter post or e-mail. Termination by telephone does not satisfy this written requirement.

6. Springer Fachmedien will process users' personal data in accordance with the Springer Fachmedien privacy policy for the "springerprofessional" platform, which can be found under the following link:
